Financials

- Restore Sales for November \$ 65,600 vs Budget \$ 62,000
- The round Up program generated \$439 in the month of November.

Staff

- Bill Case is Returning from medical leave on January 15, 2020. He will be on Restricted duty, which means No Lifting. No time frame for the Restriction has been given as of this date.
- We currently have one Full-time Connecting Point participant.

Fundraising/Procurement

- Canned Food Drive. We are continuing our Collection of Canned/Dry food goods. We will be working with Interfaith Food Ministry going forward; In Process.
We are looking into being a Year-Round Collection station for Interfaith Food Ministry.
- Working on Coordinating with local merchants to receive their Returns or Trade-in appliances and/or Furnishings. In Process.
- We have designed a new partnership program with the Nevada Union High School ROP Director. The program is called the **SMER Program**: Small Engine Repair.
Overview: The program works like the Seven Hills Bike Program.
We receive donated 2 stroke (2 cycle) engine equipment; ie, weedwackers, edgers, and many of them must be disposed of because they do not work. We send those to the school for repair in their class and they return functioning units to restore. They become part of the **SMER** inventory and we share a portion of the revenue with the schoolr.
