The Cashier/Floater position's primary responsibility is to serve as ReStore Cashier, greet and assist customers, answer questions and provide information about ReStore and about the Nevada County Habitat affiliate. The Cashier/Floater is also responsible to process the customer sale transactions in an efficiently and courteous manner and to work closely with the Store Manager on various duties, including processing donations, stocking, cleaning, organizing, and other duties as needed. **Hours: 25+ hours per week Tuesday-Saturday (Part-time)**

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Greet customers by phone or in person, provide assistance as needed
- Ensure reduced wait times for customers in line to pay for items
- Know and be able to explain the layout of the ReStore and range of inventory on hand
- Operate a cash register to document sale of merchandise and bag and package sold items
- Process cash, credit card, and check transactions with accuracy, following established procedures
- Maintain and balance cash drawers at the end of each day
- · Maintain an orderly and clean check out area
- Directing pricing and operation questions to designated staff
- Be able to multi-task in a fast-paced environment
- Assisting with processing donations for sale: cleaning, pricing, stocking items on shelves, and cleaning and organizing areas of store
- Exhibit positive working attitude and respect for fellow workers, volunteers, donors, and customers
- Participate in required training

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Lifting up to 25 pounds without assistance
- Bending, twisting, reaching, pushing, pulling, and performing repetitive motions
- · Standing, bending, and walking throughout shift
- Processing merchandise and moving to sales floor
